### BISHOP'S OFFICE

**Support Marriage Amendment:** The Iowa Catholic Conference is asking you to contact your legislator in support of an amendment to Iowa's constitution to define marriage as being between one woman and one man. Last summer, a district court struck down Iowa's law which maintains that only a marriage between a man and a woman is valid. The ruling has been stayed pending an appeal to the Iowa Supreme Court. Legislative leadership does not want to bring an amendment to a vote, so the only way to accomplish this will be to encourage legislators to contact their leadership and ask for a vote. **Mileage Reimbursement Rate:** The IRS increased the maximum mileage reimbursement rate. Since it is the middle of our fiscal year, the diocesan directors decided to change the diocesan rate effective July 1, 2008. This will give entities time to budget for the increase next year. The new diocesan rate will be 47 cents per mile.

Seventy-five percent of Rice Bowl proceeds go to help fund development projects designed to increase food security in communities in over 40 countries. 25% of the money remains in our diocese.
