Registration and Fees:

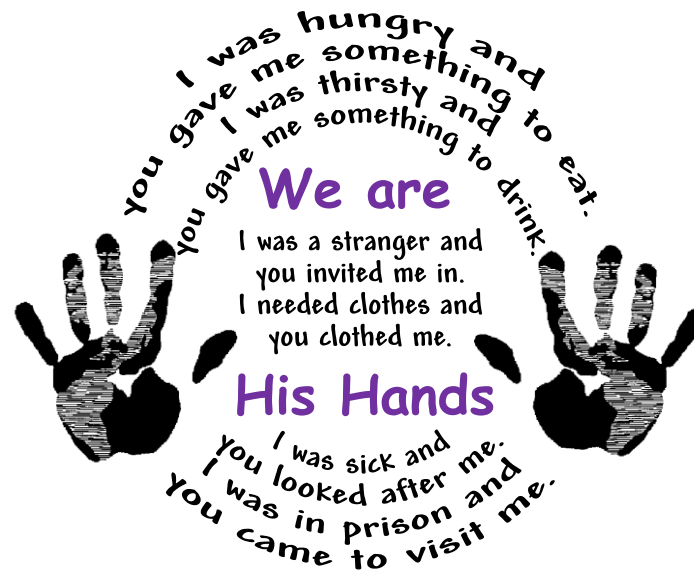

After June 11th, each Team Leader will receive an informative email with copies of the medical release forms and packing lists attached.

Group Registration Policy

Registration for Catholics in Action is done by parish team. A parish team is considered to be three to five youth and an adult leader. A maximum of six youth from one parish will be accepted per Catholics in Action team. Smaller parishes are urged to join with neighboring parishes to form a team. **Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and is limited to 80 youth.** If a parish would like to send an additional team, that team would be put on a waiting list for

availability giving other parishes the opportunity to register their first team. Please refer to the Team Registration Form for additional deadline and payment information.

The Catholics in Action Program

Catholics in Action is a three-day service opportunity designed to teach young people about the need for direct service and social change, give them the opportunity to work with people in need, and then reflect on the needs of people in their own communities.

Catholics in Action offers parish teams an opportunity for awareness and skills development through an exciting period of learning, service and community living. The program is team-based with each parish team working together, sharing together and growing together. The Catholics in Action process includes prayer and worship, journaling, recreation and social time.

Who Should Attend?

Catholics in Action is for:

◆ *Young people, ages 14-18 (including those preparing to enter their freshman year in high school and graduating high school seniors).*

Each candidate should be involved in parish activities and be mature enough to handle a variety of service experiences.

- Please note that you must attend the entire retreat. If sports or job commitments prevent this, please do not sign up for CIA.

◆ **Adult Participants/Team Leaders**

Catholics in Action is also a highly valuable learning experience for the adult. Adults must be at least 21 years old and are expected to be present for the entire time. Adults are expected to provide transportation for the team to and from work sites and to participate fully in the Catholics in Action process.

CATHOLICS IN ACTION

The Catholics in Action experience is built around these components:

Education

All participants will be introduced to the basics of Catholic Social Teaching and its implications for daily life.

Service

Each parish team will get the opportunity to experience several different types of service to people in need. It is hoped that the teams will participate in service projects in rural, urban, and multicultural environments, and will have the opportunity to plan for future projects to complete when they return to their home parishes.

Prayer

Each day there will be time for individual prayer and reflection, prayer in team groups, journaling, and worship with the other parish teams from throughout the diocese.

Community

There will be an opportunity for fun and recreation on a daily basis. Teams will share meals together and get to meet other youth from across the diocese.
