Hahnenberg, Ph.D. is associate professor of theology at Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio, where he teaches courses in theological method, ecclesiology, liturgy, and contemporary Catholicism. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Notre Dame in 2002. He is the author of two books—*Ministries: A Relational Approach* (Crossroad, 2003) and *A Concise Guide to the Documents of Vatican II* (St. Anthony Messenger Press, 2007) and numerous articles in academic and pastoral journals. A native of Michigan, he and his family live in Loveland, Ohio.
