ILLINOIS/IOWA RESIDENTS REQUIREMENTS FOR ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS

FROM THE BENEFICIARY

- Birth Certificate
- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Decree (if it applies) previous marriage certificate with divorce or death certificate
- Medical Exam (ONLY WITH AUTHORIZED DR'S)
- Proof of legal Entry I-94 and Passport with visa approval notice of I-130
- 3 Photos (Frontal view, **recent** taken within 30 days)
- Proof of entry into the U.S. prior to Dec. 21, 2000 to qualify for Secc. 245(i)

FROM THE PETITIONER

- Birth Certificate and/or Naturalization Certificate and (Green Card if priority date has been reached)
- Divorce Decree (If it applies)
- Letter from employer
- 3 years of Income Taxes (1040 federal forms & W-2's)

IMMIGRATION FEES

- I-130 Petition for Alien Relative \$ 420.00
- I-485 Adjustment of Status + fingerprints (**with legal entry**) \$ 1,70.00
- I-485 Adjustment of Status (+f-prints + work permit + penalty fee) \$2,070.00
- If under 14 and filing with I-485 of at least one parent \$ 600.00
- Under 14 NOT filing with I-485 of at least one parent \$ 985.00
- If 79 or Older \$ 985.00

\$ 400.00 Adjustment of Status Packet for 17 yr and over

\$ 300.00 Adjustment of Status (Children 16 and under)

\$ 250.00 I-130 Petition for Alien Relative

\$ 150.00 I-130 Petition for Minor Children

\$ 200.00 I-130 Petition for children born out of the marriage

\$ 150.00 I-864 Co-sponsor and an additional \$80.00 for I-864A (if the Co-sponsor is married)
